PARKING PERMIT REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

- 1. A student must have a valid driver's license in order to apply for a parking permit.
- 2. Students parking on school grounds on the *FIRST DAY of SCHOOL August 21 MUST* purchase a parking permit *PRIOR* to the first day of school. This includes students attending Vantage Career Center or the ESC, *AND* for any vehicle driven to school, including motorcycles, mopeds, and scooters.

Permits will be sold from 9:00 to 3:00 on a "First Come, First Serve" basis on the following dates:

- August 7 **SENIORS ONLY**
- August 8 JUNIORS and Seniors
- August 9 **SOPHOMORES**, Juniors, and Seniors
- August 10-11 & 14-18 Any students eligible
- 3. A **COMPLETED** form **SIGNED** by **BOTH** parent and student, and the **\$15 permit fee** must be submitted to the High School Office for a parking permit to be issued. Checks payable to Parkway Schools.
- 4. If more students register for parking than there are spaces available, the registration form will be held in the High School Office until, if and when, a student space becomes available.
- 5. Students who obtain their driver's license during the school year and wish to park on school grounds, *MUST* follow the guidelines above.
- 6. If you lose your parking permit, a replacement permit must be purchased for \$15.

DRIVING RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. **School parking is a privilege, not a right!** Students who refuse to cooperate with the rules and regulations will be denied this privilege. A student may also lose their parking permit for unacceptable behavior.
- 2. Park in your issued parking spot. Do not park in designated staff areas, handicapped spaces, fire zones or any unauthorized areas or your vehicle may be towed at your expense.
- 3. Parking permits must be displayed on the **INSIDE OF THE FRONT WINDSHIELD IN PLAIN SIGHT** in any vehicle parked in the school parking lot. The permit number must be visible from outside the vehicle.
- 4. Selling, trading, loaning or giving away your parking permit at any time is prohibited. Parking privileges for ALL parties involved will be revoked immediately and indefinitely.
- 5. Students will obey ALL parking lot supervisors and traffic control devices.
- 6. Blocking or double parking is prohibited. Students must obey and follow proper driving and parking rules.
- 7. Students are to show good judgment when entering or exiting the parking lot. No speeding or reckless driving will be tolerated. *The speed limit on school grounds is 10 MPH.*
- 8. All vehicle traffic in the student lot will yield to all school buses. School buses **ALWAYS** have the "right of way."
- 9. Do not drive on Buckeye Street, located in front of the school, while buses are loading, unloading, entering or exiting.
- 10. Students are **NOT** permitted to park behind the school from 7:00am to 4:00pm on days that school is in session.
