AgGrow Expo

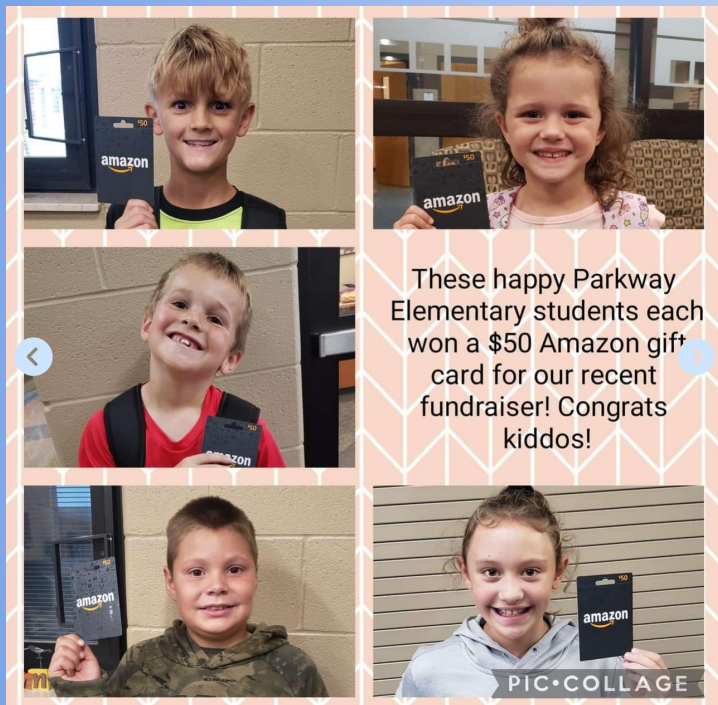
