

Parkway Athletic Update

8/27/20

Due to the COVID 19 pandemic, there have been major changes in how the Athletic Department operates. Listed below are the changes most relevant to our athletes and fans. Your patience during this difficult time is greatly appreciated!

- 1. SCHEDULE CHANGES:** There has been a great deal of changes to our Fall schedules. There will most likely continue to be additional changes. You are encouraged to keep checking the website regularly for updates in the event of further changes.
- 2. PASSES/RESERVED SEATS:** The Athletic Department will not be selling any passes this fall. Passes could *potentially* be sold for the winter season. All purchased reserved seats for Football and Basketball, from the 19/20 season, will remain the same for this season. **No one will lose their reserved seat this season.**
- 3. NFHS APP:** In light of the regulations limiting fan attendance, Parkway's fans are still in a great position to watch our home games this season. Fans can purchase viewing rights to livestream home events. There is a camera at the Football stadium, the ELE/JH Gymnasium, HS Gymnasium and the Auditorium. Currently, there are two other schools in the MAC that have the same camera system installed. Another 4 schools are in the process of obtaining the system as well. When Parkway travels to those other schools, paid subscribers will be able to view those events as well. To access/re-up, please go to the district website. Click on the Athletics tab. - 4. FAN ATTENDANCE:** Due to restrictions placed on schools, fan attendance will be limited to a small number of family/household members. **THERE WILL BE NO GENERAL PUBLIC TICKET SALES THIS FALL SEASON.** Below is a breakdown by sport of how many tickets will be allotted per player for each **HOME** event. **(For away contests, it is expected that only 2 tickets will be allotted per each player.)**
 - JH Volleyball: 6 tickets per player. Each ticket will cost \$4.
 - HS Volleyball: 6 tickets per player. Each ticket will cost \$6.
 - JH Football: 4 tickets per player/cheerleader. Each ticket will cost \$4.

d. HS Football: 2 tickets per player/cheerleader/band member. Each ticket will cost \$7. Pre-sale tickets will be sold in the HS office on Wednesday and Thursday of game week. 8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. The main ticket gate (South end) will be the only gate opened for all home Football contests. Gate will open at 6:00 p.m. There is a limit of 2 tickets per family. Example: one family has a Football player and a Band member. That family only gets 2 tickets and not 4.

e. There will be no charge for home contests in Freshman Football and Volleyball. Each team member will be allowed 4 family members admittance to the contest. NO GENERAL PUBLIC WILL BE ALLOWED.

5. FAN EXPECTATIONS AT CONTESTS:

- a. **Wearing masks at all times is expected.** If you have a condition that does not allow you to wear a mask, you should strongly consider not attending. We must wear masks to avoid being shut down.
- b. Spectators must conduct daily symptom assessments. Anyone experiencing symptoms must stay at home.
- c. Family/household members should sit together and socially distance themselves from other individuals/groups.
- d. Six feet of social distancing must be maintained between groups.
- e. No congregating before/during/after contests.
- f. If you attend a home or away contest that requires a ticket/voucher to enter, you will not be allowed to enter unless you have that ticket/voucher.
